Harrison, Administrative Law Judge (hereafter "ALJ") 18 of the Administrative Hearing Bureau. On August 23, 2013, the parties submitted a fully-19 executed Stipulation and Request for Proposed Decision and Order to the ALJ (hereafter 20 "Stipulation"). 21 The ALJ considered the declarations offered by the parties and prepared a Proposed 22 Decision which accepted the Stipulation and determined that the settlement, taken as a whole, is 23 fundamentally fair, adequate and reasonable. The ALJ submitted his Proposed Decision dated 24 November 14, 2013, and recommended its adoption as the decision of the Insurance 25 Commissioner. The Commissioner then considered the adoption of the Proposed Decision. 26 Now, therefore, pursuant to the provisions of California Insurance Code Section 27

1861.08(c) and California Government Code Section 11517(c)(2)(C), IT IS SO ORDERED that

the attached Proposed Decision is hereby adopted by the Insurance Commissioner as his decision in the above entitled matter.

Reconsideration of this Decision may be had pursuant to California Government Code
Section 11521 and California Code of Regulations, Title 10, Section 2659.1. The power to order

later than the effective date of the Decision.
