

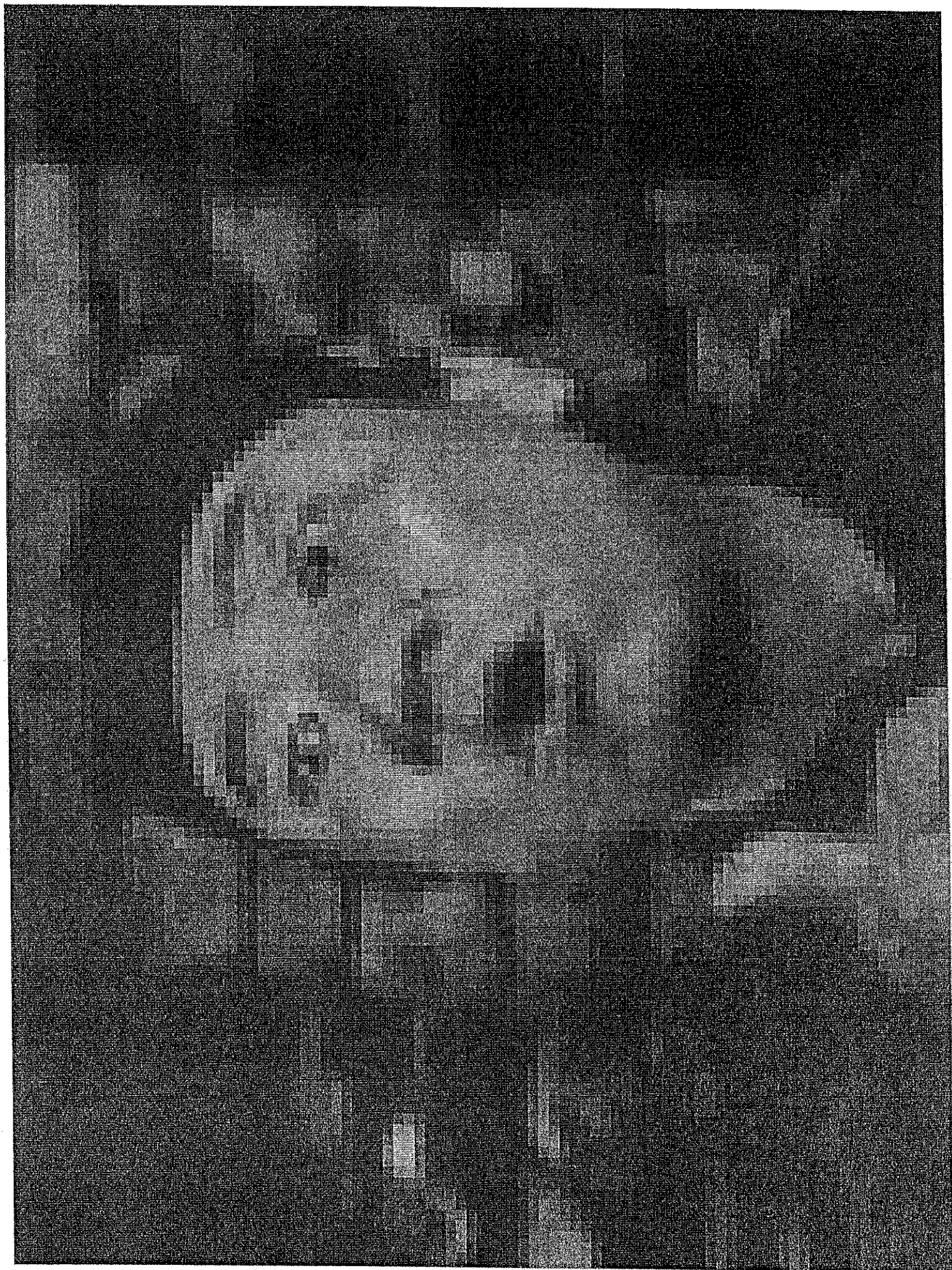

Dear Sam,

Pursuant to our discussion together on Friday, April 18 regarding the Playa del Rey (SCPNO. 0997, FILE NO. 204EN00) and Gardena (SCP NO. 0470A, FILE NO. 2047900) sites, LADPH has internally reviewed the findings to date. We believe that the preliminary findings represent a significant potential exposure to the public, and require additional investigation.

We concur with you that the next step should entail further characterization of these 2 sites, by verifying the projected exposure levels in the indoor spaces based on these preliminary results. Given the need for prompt action on this matter, LADPH would advise the RWQCB to request the support of the AQMD to provide assistance for sampling.

Our review of site history records for the Playa Del Rey site shows a number documents regarding site assessment, violation notices, cleanup and abatement orders, and other correspondence with property owners from 2000-2014, in addition to a request for assistance from the EPA. We would like to receive further clarification regarding the various actions that have been taken during over that time period by the responsible parties involved.

In addition, LADPH is available to assist the RWQCB for the public notification phase of these assessments. Please keep us informed as to the progress of your plans for further site assessment, scheduling, and public messaging. We will continue to provide our input as the investigation continues, and please call us with any questions.

Barry, this morning we had a call with Sam Unger re a site where our assistance was requested. The facility has released chlorinated solvents to soil and shallow groundwater. It has been closed for some time. Based on contaminant levels in soils, preliminary risk estimates in the building are elevated.

There are no current air emission sources but there is concern about whether soil and groundwater contaminants have migrated laterally and present an exposure to occupied residential structures less than 100 ft away. Paula Rasmussen is trying to set a meeting with appropriate agencies to discuss appropriate follow-up. We suggested requesting help from you, and said we would identify a good contact for them to invite to the initial meeting next week. Please let me know who we should be dealing with on your staff and I will pass that on to the group. Thanks.

Angelo Bellomo and I just had a telephone meeting with Sam Unger and Paula Rasmussen at the Regional Water Quality Control Board. They wanted to discuss 2 sites in which residents were at risk of exposure to subsurface VOC's. They were asking for our assistance in next steps for site assessment, potential notifications, and plans for further characterization of the sites. The sites in question are.

SITE(1) FORMER DEL REY CLEANERS SITE, 310 CULVER BOULEVARD, PLAYA DEL REY, CALIFORNIA (SCPNO. 0997, FILE NO. 204EN00);

SITE(2) UNIDENTIFIED SITE IN GARDENA - DISCOVERED DURING AN OFF-SITE WORK FOR BP/HITCO SITE LOCATED AT 1600 WEST 135 STREET, GARDENA, CALIFORNIA (SCP NO. 0470A, FILE NO. 2047900)

We thought that Health Hazmat would be the natural agency to refer the matter, for an initial assessment. In addition, we are going to contact the AQMD to see if they have any guidance to offer. We may hold a brief teleconference sometime next week so that we might all have a chance to discuss the matter together as agencies. In the meantime, Shahid, I gave your contact info to the Water Board so that they could contact you for an initial discussion about the current situation.
